In 2022 she was responsible for one of the "Lebanon on Stage" locations and helped raise money for the Order's projects in Lebanon.

In her free time, she tries to foster what she experienced as a volunteer in Austria, Germany, France, and Lebanon through working with differently abled people in her hometown. To make the values of the Order a reality around the world speaks to her greatly as a politically engaged and strong Catholic.
