Professor Mark J. Wolff is an expert in taxation (domestic and international), and has experience in teaching a wide variety of tax courses at St. Thomas University School of Law including: Federal Income Taxation; Federal Estate & Gift Taxation; Corporate Taxation; Estate Planning; Comparative International Taxation; Tax Policy; International Taxation of Business Transactions; Agency and Partnership; Advanced Issues in Taxation; Selected Issues in Taxation; Business Associations; Agency and Partnership; Contracts as well as Advanced Jurisprudence Seminars. He also coaches the National Tax Moot Court Competition Team for St. Thomas Law School. He is currently serving as the Executive Director of the Miami-Dade County Educational Facilities Authority, responsible for the issuance of tax-exempt bond financing for institutions of higher education in Miami-Dade County. Since Professor Wolff has acted as Executive Director of the Authority, it has issued 2.5 billion in tax-exempt bonds for institutions of higher learning in Miami-Dade County, without ever experiencing a single default.

Professor Wolff also serves on the Editorial Board of the Florida Bar Journal & News and is an active member of the ABA and Florida Bar Tax Sections, serving as Director of Law Student Outreach, for the Education Division of the Tax Section. In 1984, Professor Wolff founded the STULS/VITA Program at St. Thomas University School of Law, which partners with the Internal Revenue Service to prepare federal tax returns for low-income members of the South Florida community. In 2019 STULS/VITA had its' 35th Anniversary and exceeded 10 Million Dollars in taxpayer refunds. Professor Wolff is accredited to the United Nations as an Advisor and has addressed United Nations World and International Conferences and the
