Gregory currently serves as an Advisor to the Permanent Observer Mission of the Sovereign Order of Malta to the United Nations in New York City. He has previously served in the Singapore Armed Forces, the Provisional Technical Secretariat of the Comprehensive Test-Ban Treaty Organization in Vienna and the Order's embassy in Timor Leste. He obtained his LLB in International Relations from Peking University, his MA in Modern History and Politics from Oxford University, where he is a member of the Middle Common Room at Greyfriars, and his global Masters of Arts from Tufts University Fletcher School of Diplomacy.

A Singaporean, he joined the Order with the Australian Association and transferred to the American Association in 2019, making his promise of obedience in 2022. He is married with two sons, one born in Australia and who spent his toddler years in Austria, the other a newborn delivered at Turtle Bay.

His intellectual and academic interests are primarily of a historical bent, especially about the Rittersturm during the last years of the Holy Roman Empire, the Austrian Hungarian legacy, New Qing History, ML-KNIL/ Royal Netherlands Navy in the Far East, small states and island dependencies, and most of all, the survival of small particularist states during the rise and fall of great powers in diplomatic history. This comes about as a legacy of his training in Imperial and Commonwealth History and personal heritage.

Gregory's main assignment at the Mission is to monitor the proceedings of the United Nations Security Council.
